The Building Skills Partnership (BSP) is a statewide non-profit organization made possible through a collaboration between community members, responsible businesses, Building Owners Managers Association (BOMA) and SEIU-USWW. BSP's mission is to improve the quality of life and advancement of SEIU-USWW building service workers, by providing access to quality educational opportunities.

Mike Garcia strongly believed that higher education and leadership are key to helping enhance and improve the lives of Union members, their families and our communities. Therefore, BSP is proud to announce its Mike Garcia Leadership Scholarship competition for the 2022-2023 academic year. This application is open to members of SEIU-USWW and their children to help offset some of the rising costs of a higher education and to nurture the growth of future leaders.

Mike's commitment to upholding the rights and dignity of immigrant workers has inspired statewide campaigns, helping janitors and their families achieve social and economic justice across California. The son of a Union factory worker, Mike worked as a janitor to support his own college education. Mike shared his vision for the American dream not only through his vital contributions to the fight for workers' rights, but by elevating higher education opportunities for immigrant janitors' children.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Must be a SEIU-USWW member or member's child.
- Must be entering, or continuing their education, at a 2-year community college, 4-year university, or vocational institution in the fall of 2022.
- Use the award for the 2022-2023 Academic year.
- Have a Grade Point Average of 2.0 or higher.

Additionally, the applicant must turn in the following documents to Building Skills Partnership no later than June 4th, 2022.
